## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE TRENTON MISSOURI

The <u>City of Trenton</u> will hold a public hearing on <u>August 13, 2024, 3:00 p.m.</u> at <u>City Hall located at Trenton City Hall, 1100 Main Street, Trenton, MO 64683</u> to discuss the city's submission of an Competitive Cycle application for the fiscal year <u>2023/2024</u> Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Demolition program. The city is interested in obtaining all citizens' input on community development needs within the city. As part of the hearing process, citizens will be asked to verbally assist in the completion of a Needs Assessment document. The document will detail what the residents feel are the strengths and weaknesses of the community. The city needs as much local participation as possible in order to reflect the true desires of the community as a whole, as well as the comments relating to the proposed project application. The State has established a maximum application request for each funding category.

Activities that are eligible for funding include the improvement of Community Facilities, Demolition, General Infrastructure, and others allowed by law. At least 51% of the funds must be used to benefit low-and-moderate income persons. No displacement of persons is anticipated. The city is proposing to demolish all vacant dilapidated houses within city limits. The area to be addressed is bounded within the city limits.

The total project cost is estimated at \$377,000. The city proposes to contribute \$72,000 in cash, \$5,000 in-kind labor by city crews, with grant funds of \$300,000 needed to make up the balance. The project, if funded, will benefit 57% low/moderate income persons. All citizens, including those in the targeted area, are encouraged to attend to comment on the proposed activities.
